Documentation Requirements – Commercial Imports.

Commercial Imports – Goods that are either being imported for sale or business purposes.

Requirements:

- 1. A valid EORI number.
- 2. Suppliers invoice, which contains a detailed description and value of the goods being imported.
- 3. Suppliers packing list if available.
- 4. Copy of shipping documentation. Airwaybill / Sea Bills of Lading.

Commercial Samples – Goods being imported as a one-off / not for resale.

Requirements:

- 1. A valid EORI number.
- 2. Suppliers invoice, which contains a detailed description and value of the goods being imported.
- 3. Suppliers invoice must clearly state that the item is being sent as a sample and the item itself must be "marked, defaced or altered in someway so it cannot be sold". (Customs will inspect such items).
- 4. Suppliers packing list if available.
- 5. Copy of shipping documentation. Airwaybill / Sea Bills of Lading.

British Return Goods – Goods previously exported from the UK that are being returned to the original UK Shipper.

Requirements:

- 1. A valid EORI number.
- 2. A copy of the original "export entry" when the goods left the UK.
- A copy of the original "export shipping documents". This needs to be a freight forwarder certified Airwaybill, Bill of Lading or Courier Consignment Note.
- 4. Copy of the current shipping documentation. Airwaybill / Sea Bills of Lading.
